

The Swedish Research Institute in Istanbul



Travel grant and stay in Istanbul in the fall of 2018

The SWEDISH RESEARCH INSTITUTE IN ISTANBUL hereby announces a number of travel grants reserved for a limited stay at the institute in the fall of 2018. The Swedish Research Institute is located within the compound of the Swedish Consulate General in the city centre of Istanbul.

Applicants, irrespective of their area of research, should be affiliated to a Swedish or Nordic university at early or advanced level (B. A., M. A., or PhD education). The primary aim of the stay in Istanbul should be to work on a thesis.

The grant amounts to **2500 SEK** for financing, in part or whole, a flight ticket to Istanbul and back again. Apart from that, the grant holder disposes of a room, free of rent, at the Swedish Research Institute for a period of about three weeks, primarily in the periods of August 27 – September 16, or December 1-21. Requests for other periods of stay will depend on whether rooms are available. The grant must be used before the end of 2018 or will otherwise be reimbursed.

The application should contain contact information, desired period of stay (early or late, or other), a short description (no more than one A4 page) of the work intended to be done, and a certificate from a prefect, professor or teacher about the ongoing education of the applicant.

The deadline for application is June 16, 2018 irrespective of period of stay. The decision is made by the director and deputy director of the SRII. The application should be sent as an e-mail with attachments to either the director Kristina Josephson Hesse (kristina.hesse@sri.org.tr) or the deputy director Olof Heilo (olof.heilo@sri.org.tr).
